

ADDITIONAL RULES FOR THE 2018 ACHA CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

Western Attire (western hat/equestrian helmet, boots, long sleeved shirt buttoned or snapped down the front, with collars and with sleeves rolled down) must be adhered to at all times while in the Expo Arena.

Expo Arena consists of warm up area, alley and show pen

- 1. Only horses and riders who have <u>qualified</u> under current ACHA rules may enter the Championship Show. The ACHA staff will check all entries. Horses and riders entered in the limited age events held in conjunction with the Championship Show <u>do not</u> have to qualify.
- 2. Entries for <u>Aged Events and All Regular Weekend Classes</u> are due in the ACHA office by January 4, 2019 by 5:00 PM. There will be NO grace period. Credit Cards <u>will not</u> be accepted.
- 3. All entries which have not paid entry fees at the time of the draw will be cancelled and not in the draw.
- 4. Late entries for <u>Limited Aged Events and All Regular Weekend Classes</u> will be accepted until the draw with a \$100.00 late fee penalty.
- 5. ACHA has the right to refuse any entry without notice, or cancel an event without notice, but entry fees will be returned.
- 6. The draw for the working order will be posted on the ACHA website at www.achactting.org on January 12.
- 7. No refunds will be made for any reason after the draw.
- 8. Points earned in each of the 2 Go Rounds will count toward 2018 Year End Weekend Class Standings.
- 9. Prizes for Champions and Reserve Champions in each class will be determined by the highest cumulative score. Any ties will be broken by money earned. If still tied, prizes will be duplicated.
- 10. All prize money will be paid each day according to Rule 20 D, page 27, based on number of entries.
- 11. A two (2) judge system will be used and the 2 scores added together for a final score, each day.
- 12. All other rules of the ACHA shall be strictly enforced.
- 13. ACHA reserves the right to cancel any class for lack of entries, natural disasters or other valid reasons as determined by the ACHA Board of Directors.
- 14. A stall will be required for all horses.
- 15. In the event of conflict of these Additional Rules with the Standing Rules and Bylaws of the ACHA, these Additional Rules shall govern.

BELL COUNTY EXPO RULES WE MUST FOLLOW:

- 1. Smoking is prohibited in all facilities at the Bell County Expo Center.
- 2. No pets are permitted in Expo and must be on leash if outside.
- 3. No alcohol may be brought onto Expo premises at any time.
